Advance Planning: What is a MOST form?

The Medical Orders for Scope of Treatment (MOST) form is a 1-page, 2-sided document that consolidates and summarizes patient preferences for key life-sustaining treatments including: CPR, general scope of treatment, antibiotics, artificial nutrition and hydration.

On the form, individuals may refuse treatment, request full treatment, or specify limitations. The standardized form can be easily and quickly understood by patients, health care providers, and emergency personnel. It is primarily intended to be used by the chronically or seriously ill person in frequent contact with health care providers.

The MOST form is completed by the patient or authorized agent in conversation with a health care provider, then signed by the patient/agent and a physician, advanced practice nurse, or physician's assistant. The physician/APN/PA signature translates patient preferences into medical orders. The MOST form "travels" with the patient and is honored in any setting: hospital, clinic, day surgery, long-term care facility, adult day program, ALR, hospice, or at home.

The portability of the form allows seamless documentation of treatment preferences and closes gaps as patients transfer from setting to setting or experience delays in access to providers.
