## Health Care Issues at End of Life

On Tuesday, **Sept. 22**, at 10 a.m. we will be giving a free seminar with our nurse staff Tracy, Donna, and Caroline, to help you to thread your way through the forest of **"Advanced Directives Planning."**

Basically, this means ways you can plan ahead for care preferences in the last stages of life - when you or your loved one might be unable to voice them. We will discuss and provide information covering DNR (Do Not Resuscitate) and DNI (Do Not Intubate) orders, living wills, durable medical powers of attorney, Five Wishes, the M.O.S.T. (Colorado Medical Orders for Scope of Treatment) form, hospice and palliative care, as well as organ and tissue donation.
